#### MONDAY 1 SAMUEL 15 – 35 – 1 SAMUEL 16

1. “Samuel mourned – the Lord repented” Discuss God’s purposes
2. “How long wilt thou mourn?”
3. “Fill thine horn with oil, and go!”
4. I have provided me a king, among his sons”.
5. Samuel looked on Eliab . “Surely the Lord’s anointed”.
6. The DIVINE PERSPECTIVE
7. The forgotten son – “There remaineth yet the youngest”.
8. He keepeth the sheep Discuss “keepeth”
9. Arise – anoint him!: FOR THIS IS HE”
10. The Spirit of the Lord came upon David

5. What is the role of a CAPTAIN over them?

6. Discuss these points:
  - a. They separated unto Him
  - b. They submitted unto Him
  - c. They recognized His authority over them
  - d. They had affection for Him
  - e. They were devoted to Him

**THURSDAY 2ND SAMUEL 11**

**DAVIDS SIN AND RESTORATION**

1. What hint do we get from verse 1 when we see others kings went to battle – but David sent Joab?
2. David’s sin involved 4 areas
  - a. He *saw*
  - b. He *sent*
  - c. *He inquired*
  - d. He *took*
3. As we read Numbers 32 vs 23, we hear God saying “Be sure your sin will find you out”! We hear the results of this sin in vs 5 – “I am with child”
4. Immediately we see a plan developed to hide the sin – but David forgets – He is dealing with the living God
5. David also learns he is dealing with a devoted man as his plans fail.
6. Hear the words of Uriah in verse 11 – “I will not do this thing”!
7. There is only one thing left to do – Discuss vs 14 & 15
8. The plan of David works and he is done with Uriah! Vs 21 and vs 25.

**CHAPTER 12 VS 1 – 18**

1. “The Lord sent Nathan unto David” vs 1 - Discuss
2. Discuss the story given to David and the response of David!
3. Listen to the verdict rendered by Nathan “Thou art the Man”
4. Discuss the declaration of God in vs 9 – 10 & 12.
5. Verse 13 – David reaches the end of the terrible plan.
6. Complete this reading today with Psalm 51.
